
## **Accident Reporting Procedures**





In the event of an emergency, the appropriate emergency services should be summoned.

- Call 2222 for emergency medical assistance
- Call 4444 in the event of a fire
- Call 4444 for the hospital security

In the case of a medical emergency or any other form of accident, however small, you should report it. Examples would include cuts, bruises, needle jabs etc. that occur as accidents or incidents within the Centre.

As a first point of call speak to one of the WIN Radiographers.

Other than for very minor incidents, an accident/incident form should be completed using the University online Health & Safety Incident Report Form: <a href="https://oxforduni-remoteforms.info-exchange.com/Incident">https://oxforduni-remoteforms.info-exchange.com/Incident</a>

The senior radiographers should also be informed if staff are aware of a near-miss incident, for example where someone could have been injured or put at risk, even if no injury occurred.
