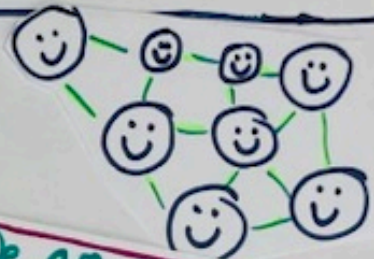


Inclusive Research @ WIN: Improving Tools, Processes, & Methods for Underserved Groups

We paid a diverse group of participants to identify where we should do better and worked with WIN researchers and staff to implement changes suggested



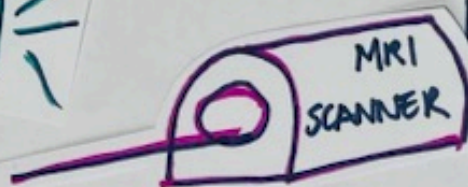
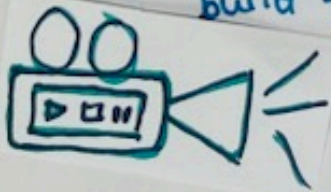
We are setting up a Community Connector Programme to work more closely with diverse communities
